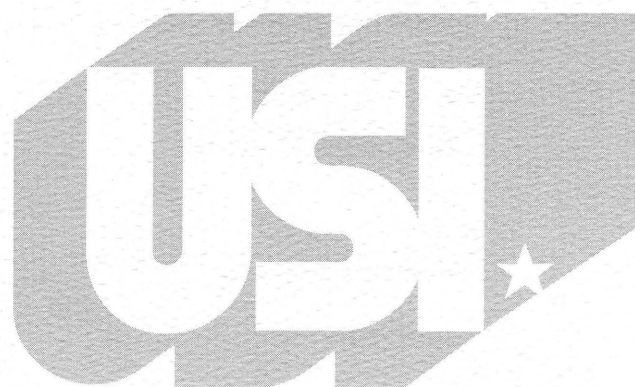

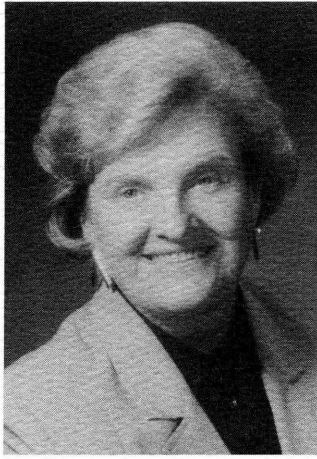

## LARRAINE R. MATUSAK

### WILL BRING COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS AND BE HONORED FOR NATIONAL LEADERSHIP ROLE

The Commencement Address will be delivered by Dr. Lorraine R. Matusak, who has enjoyed a distinguished career in the fields of education and leadership. Earlier this year, Dr. Matusak became the first Leadership Scholar at the W.K. Kellogg Foundation. The Kellogg Foundation was established in 1930 to "help people help themselves." As a private grantmaking foundation, it provides seed money to organizations and institutions that have identified problems and have designed constructive action programs aimed at solutions. A majority of the Foundation's grantmaking is focused on the areas of youth, leadership, philanthropy and volunteerism, community-based health services, higher education, food systems, rural development, groundwater resources (in the Great Lakes area), and economic development (in Michigan).

As Kellogg's Leadership Scholar, Dr. Matusak writes, speaks, and consults with national organizations and foundations on leadership development. The author of numerous publications in the field of nontraditional adult education and leadership, Dr. Matusak has been asked by noted biographer and leadership scholar James MacGregor Burns to write the first book in a new series on leadership. To be known as *The Library of Leadership*, the series will focus on the nature, meaning, future, and application of leadership.

Before joining the Kellogg Foundation in 1982, Dr. Matusak was president of Thomas A. Edison State College in Trenton, New Jersey; dean of Alternative Programs at the University of Evansville; and professor of natural sciences at the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis. She has spent more than 30 years as a professor and administrator in secondary and postsecondary education. In 1974, Dr. Matusak received the Outstanding American Educator Award from the Medical College of Georgia in Augusta.

Dr. Matusak received a bachelor's degree in biology and chemistry from the College of St. Benedict; a master's degree in entomology from the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis; and a doctorate in higher education administration from Fielding Institute of Graduate Studies in Santa Barbara, California.

In addition to her many professional endeavors, Dr. Matusak has shared her time and talent with organizations working to improve the quality of life. She serves as president of the board of S.A.F.E. Place, a shelter for women and children in Battle Creek, Michigan; board member of the Battle Creek Symphony; and vice chair of the board of trustees of the College of St. Benedict.

The University will confer an honorary Doctor of Laws degree on Dr. Matusak during the Commencement ceremony.

## SUSAN ROBERTA ENLOW

### WILL BE RECOGNIZED FOR HUMANITARIAN AND EDUCATIONAL EFFORTS



As president and chief executive officer of the Enlow Foundation, a foundation supporting scholarships for minorities, female minority single parents, and the arts, Susan R. Enlow has sought to improve the condition of society and of those less fortunate. At the University of Southern Indiana, she has been a generous benefactor in establishing scholarships for deserving students as well as endowments to enhance the humanities.

She will receive an honorary Doctor of Laws degree during the ceremony.

Ms. Enlow, an active participant in the many programs the Enlow Foundation supports, is a trustee of The Stony Brook School in Long Island, New York, and is the first woman in the school's history to serve on the executive committee. She also is a trustee and chairman of the board of Fellowship Academy, an urban elementary school in San Francisco, California, and is a member of the Board of Directors of the Foundation for Advance Christian Training. An ordained elder in the Presbyterian Church, Ms. Enlow is a member of the Menlo Park (California) Presbyterian Church, and has been active in Grace Lutheran Church in Evansville.

Originally from Evansville, Ms. Enlow now divides her time between homes in California and Indiana, and has a special interest in the historic community of New Harmony. She is a member of the board of directors of the USI/Historic New Harmony Foundation, the Finance Committee of the New Harmony Commission, and the Board of Directors of the Posey County Community Foundation. She has played a key role in developing and sustaining the Ropewalk Writers Retreat and The New Harmony Project, both held annually in New Harmony.

A graduate of Indiana University, Ms. Enlow attended the Medill School of Journalism at Northwestern University and earned a master's degree from the University of Evansville. From 1963 to 1986, she was corporate secretary of the board of directors of *The Evansville Courier*. Ms. Enlow is the mother of two children.

## JAMES BRIDWELL IGLEHEART

### WILL BE HONORED FOR LEADERSHIP IN EDUCATION AND BUSINESS



James B. Igleheart has been actively involved in advancing educational opportunities while enjoying a distinguished career in business. As chairman of International Steel Company from which he recently retired, Mr. Igleheart was a national leader in the steel fabricating manufacturing industry. He served as a director of both the American Institute of Steel Construction and the National Association Manufacturers. Mr. Igleheart also is a past director of Old National Bank in Evansville.

His volunteer activities, primary among them education, have occupied an important place in Mr. Igleheart's career. For twelve years he served on the State Board of Indiana Vocational Technical College and for ten years he was a member of the Indiana Commission for Higher Education. He also was a trustee of the University of Evansville. Mr. Igleheart was a founding member of the local chapter of Junior Achievement and also of RESCUE, now known as Second Chance halfway house. He is a director and former president of the Evansville Museum of Arts and Science, an elder at First Presbyterian Church, and a member of the Rehabilitation Center board. Mr. Igleheart served on the Human Relations Commission and in 1977 received the Mayor's Human Rights Award.

Born in Evansville, Mr. Igleheart moved with his family to Greenwich, Connecticut, as a child. He was educated at The Choate School, Purdue University, and was commissioned an Ensign in the United States Naval Reserve on completion of a program at the University of Virginia. Mr. Igleheart returned to Evansville and was employed by International Steel, a company he served for 44 years.

Mr. Igleheart's achievements will be recognized with the conferral of an honorary Doctor of Laws degree in the ceremony.

Mr. Igleheart and his wife Diane are the parents of four children.

## AUGUSTINE J. FREDRICH IS 1993 DISTINGUISHED PROFESSOR



Professor Augustine J. Fredrich has been selected by his colleagues to receive the National City Bank Distinguished Professor Award. As professor of civil engineering technology and chairman of the Engineering Technology Department, he has been engaged in professional activities which demonstrate his commitment to excellence in teaching, scholarship, and service — the criteria used to select the recipient of this annual award. He will receive a monetary award, and a scholarship in his

name will be awarded to a deserving USI student. The award is made possible by a generous gift from National City Bank of Evansville.

Professor Fredrich joined the faculty of USI in 1979 after a successful career in the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, where he directed planning and design of water resources projects. A civil engineer, he earned his Bachelor of Science from the University of Arkansas and the Master of Science from California State University at Sacramento.

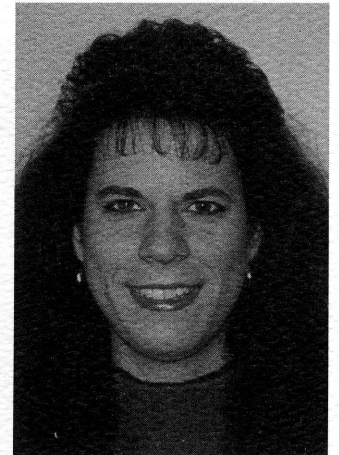
At USI, Professor Fredrich's contributions touch many facets of the University. In addition to teaching a series of undergraduate courses in his civil engineering discipline, he also teaches a master's level interdisciplinary course on the world's cathedrals. Professor Fredrich is the author of *Sons of Martha: Civil Engineering Readings in Modern Literature*, and is widely published in professional journals.

Professor Fredrich has been recognized for his service to professional engineering and educational organizations. He was named a Fellow of the American Society of Civil Engineers in 1985 and received that group's Service to Profession Award in 1986, Citizen Engineer of the Year Award for Zone II in 1991, and the prestigious Julian Hinds Award for career achievement in water resources planning and management this year.

Professor Fredrich's keen interest in young people is evident in his university and community work. He has instituted a program to counsel personally with engineering technology students experiencing academic difficulties. Sensing the need to interest more young people in engineering and science careers, Professor Fredrich designed the Career Awareness in Science and Engineering (CASE) program. For six weeks each summer, 50 middle school children undertake science and engineering projects and learn about career opportunities from employed professionals. To fund the program, he won grants from the U.S. Department of Energy and the Indiana Commission on Higher Education, and obtained contributions from local businesses and industries.

Professor Fredrich has been a school board member, an active board member for Campus Ministry, and a leader in the youth soccer program. In recognition of his extraordinary contributions to youth soccer, a local soccer field was named for him in 1988, and this spring, the Indiana Youth Soccer Association's highest award for individual service is being renamed the Jay Fredrich Award.

## SHERRY M. BEGLE IS 1993 PRESIDENT'S MEDAL RECIPIENT



In the Commencement ceremony, Sherry M. Begle will receive the 1993 President's Medal, the highest honor given a senior at the University of Southern Indiana. She was chosen for the honor by the Faculty Senate Student Academic Affairs Committee based on her commitment to academic excellence and her service to the University and the community.

Miss Begle, who has attended the University as a Presidential Scholar, is graduating *summa cum laude*, having earned a perfect 4.0 grade point average. Since completing course work for an accounting major in December, she has successfully completed the Indiana Certified Public Accountant examination and accepted employment at the Indianapolis office of KPMG Peat Marwick, the world's largest public accounting and consulting firm.

At the spring School of Business honors convocation, Miss Begle received the Wall Street Journal Award, the Indiana C.P.A. Society Award, and the Academic Achievement Award for Accounting. She has received numerous other awards and scholarships, including The Outstanding German Student and the Elks' National Foundation Scholarship. Miss Begle won first place in the regional division and second place in the national competition of the Donald W. Fogarty International Student Paper Competition for the American Production and Inventory Control Society. She also was named to Alpha Chi and Golden Key honor societies.

A campus leader, Miss Begle was president of the USI Accounting Club, secretary of the Student Alumni Association, chairman of the planning committee for the Data Processing Management Association, and a member of the Institute of Management Accountants and Student Ambassadors. She also served as a member of the Enlow Distinguished Scholar Committee and the School of Business Student Advisory Council.

While she was a student, Miss Begle held a cooperative education assignment with General Electric in Mt. Vernon. A graduate of Southridge High School, Miss Begle is the daughter of Wilfred and Cathy Begle of Huntingburg.

## Academic Dress

The academic costume dates from medieval days when university students wore woolen and fur garments for warmth in damp and drafty buildings. Most of those studying were clerics in the holy orders; they wore a cloak to which was attached a hood that could be pulled up to cover their tonsured heads. Simplified today, the costume serves to remind us that its wearer is a member of an ancient and venerable profession; it also indicates by its color and design the wearer's degree and the institution by which the degree was conferred.

In the United States, black has been the traditional color for academic gowns, but some institutions authorize holders of their doctorates to wear colors of the institution. The bachelor's gown is distinguished by its long, open sleeves; the master's by its closed, slitted sleeves; the doctor's by its full sleeves trimmed with bands of velvet, which may be black or a color denoting the field in which the degree was taken.

The mortarboard cap, proper for all degrees, is black. Tassels, usually black, are worn over the left front quarter of the cap. Holders of the doctorate may wear tassels of gold thread.

Academic hoods vary in length according to the degree attained and are lined with the colors of the institution by which the degree was granted. The honorary doctoral hoods of the University of Southern Indiana are black, lined with blue satin with red satin chevrons. They are edged with white velvet.

## The Mace of the University

In medieval England, the mace was a formidable weapon, held ready by a bodyguard who led the way for dignitaries or officers of the court. From the sixteenth century in England and since colonial days in America, the mace has become a symbol of office only, and is carried by a distinguished member of the faculty who leads the Commencement procession. Here it is carried by the Grand Marshal.

The University of Southern Indiana Mace is the cane of Richard Owen, who was a geologist and professor of natural science at Indiana University before becoming the first president of Purdue University. A respected scientist and scholar, Richard was a son of Robert Owen, the Scottish industrialist who established New Harmony, Indiana, as a center for education and enlightened social reform in the early 1800s. All the children of Robert Owen who accompanied him to America made far-reaching contributions to society, and helped to shape the governmental, social, and cultural directions of the state, region, and nation.

The baccalaureate degree candidate graduating with the highest scholarship index is graduated *summa cum laude*. Baccalaureate students graduating with a scholarship index of 3.80 or higher are graduated *magna cum laude*. Those with a scholarship index between 3.60 and 3.80 are graduated *cum laude*. These achievements are set forth on the individual diplomas. Honor students can be recognized in the Commencement Exercises by colored stoles and tassels. Gold indicates *summa cum laude*; red, *magna cum laude*; and blue, *cum laude*.

Because students enrolled in master's degree programs are expected to maintain a minimum grade point average of 3.0, and most achieve much higher levels, Commencement scholarship honors are given only to baccalaureate students.
