Between December 2016 and August 2017, a total of 2,031 graduate and undergraduate degrees and certificates were awarded to 1,960 individuals, an increase of 117 total degrees and certificates awarded compared to 2016 (1,194).



- 85% are in a full-time position


Of those not currently employed, half are actively looking for employment.
