HELEN THOMAS WILL BRING COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS

Helen Thomas, an author and Hearst Newspapers columnist, who served for 57 years as a correspondent for United Press International and UPI's White House bureau chief, will bring the Commencement Address. In the ceremony, she will receive an honorary Doctor of Letters degree in recognition of her many achievements in the field of journalism.

During her career, Ms. Thomas opened many doors for women in journalism. A graduate of Wayne State University, she first served as a copy girl on the *Washington Daily News*. In 1934, she joined United Press International and the Washington press corps. For twelve years, Ms. Thomas wrote radio news for UPI and eventually she covered the news of the federal government, including the Justice Department, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Health and Human Services, and Capitol Hill.

In 1960, she began covering then President-elect John F. Kennedy, following him to the White House in January 1961 as a member of the UPI team, then headed by the late Merriman Smith. It was during this first White House assignment that Ms. Thomas began closing presidential press conferences with "Thank you, Mr. President."

Ms. Thomas was the only woman print journalist traveling with President Nixon to China during his breakthrough trip in 1972. Since then, she has returned

to China in the entourages of former Presidents Ford, Reagan, and Bush and former Secretary of State Henry Kissinger, and has covered every economic summit.

Ms. Thomas was the first woman officer of the National Press Club after it opened its doors to women members following a 90-year span of all-male membership. She also was the first woman member of the Gridiron Club, for which she also served as president, and the first woman officer and woman president of the White House Correspondents Association. In 1976, the *World Almanac* recognized her as one of the 25 most influential women in America. She is the author of *Dateline White House*, published in 1974, and *Front Row at the White House*, published in 1999.

A Fellow of Sigma Delta Chi, the Society of Professional Journalists, Ms. Thomas also has been elected to its Hall of Fame. She holds numerous awards from colleges and universities as well as from professional organizations related to journalism. She was the first recipient of the Helen Thomas Lifetime Achievement Award established by the White House Correspondents Association and honored by former President and Mrs. Clinton at its annual dinner and presentation of the award in 1998.

Ms. Thomas is the widow of Douglas B. Cornell, an Associated Press White House correspondent, whom she married in 1971. Her nephew, Patrick J. Mabarek, is a student in the Honors Program at the University of Southern Indiana.

JAMES S. VINSON AND JAMES A. SANDERS TO BE RECOGNIZED

Two prominent community leaders, Dr. James S. Vinson and Mr. James A. Sanders, will be recognized today for their contributions to higher education.

Dr. Vinson is president and professor of physics at the University of Evansville. He will retire this year after 14 years of leadership marked by the institution's renewed commitment to mission and educational excellence. Dr. Vinson has been instrumental in forging partnerships between public and private education at all levels in southwest Indiana.

Before his appointment at the University of Evansville, he was vice president for Academic Affairs at Trinity University in Texas and dean of the College of Arts and Sciences at the University of Hartford in Connecticut. Prior teaching and administrative experiences include positions at the University of North Carolina at Asheville and MacMurray College in Illinois.

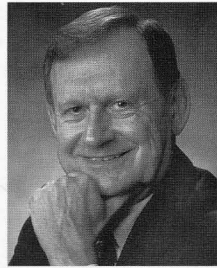
Dr. Vinson received the Bachelor of Arts degree in physics from Gettysburg College in Pennsylvania in 1963, and the Master of Science and the Doctor of Philosophy degrees in physics from the University of Virginia in 1965 and 1967. While at the University of Virginia, he received a Special Physics Fellowship and the President's Research Prize.

Active in a wide range of civic organizations, Dr. Vinson is a member of the board of directors of the Signature Learning Center, Indiana State Chamber of Commerce, Youth Resources of Southwestern Indiana, WNIN Public Broadcasting, and the Buffalo Trace Council – Boy Scouts of America. He is a member of the advisory board of St. Mary's Medical Center and the board of governors of the Petroleum Club. He also is a member of the board of directors of Southern Indiana Gas and Electric Company and its parent company, Vectren Corporation.

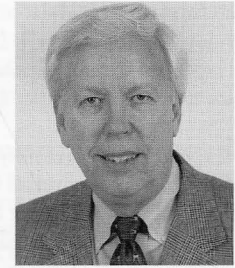
Dr. Vinson is a member of numerous professional organizations for higher education and the sciences. An active scholar, he is the author of many professional publications and is a frequent presenter at academic meetings and conferences.

Dr. Vinson and his wife Susan have two daughters, Suzannah Cordas and Elizabeth Vinson. In today's ceremony, Dr. Vinson will receive an honorary Doctor of Science degree.

Mr. James A. Sanders will receive an honorary Doctor of Laws degree in recognition of his major planned gift to the USI Foundation, which will endow Presidential Scholarships, a distinguished professorship, and the University's art collection fund.

Mr. Sanders has a distinguished career in education. He taught English and journalism in the Henderson, Kentucky, public schools from 1961-63; was a teacher and coordinator for the Evansville-Vanderburgh School Corporation from 1963-1985; and served as the district state supervisor for marketing instruction from 1965-1972. In 1985, he left teaching to become the University's first director of Historic New Harmony, where he was able to combine his marketing knowledge with his interest in historic preservation. Under Mr. Sanders's management, he moved the organization's focus from restoration to education, built the assets of the USI-New Harmony Foundation, developed new educational exhibits, and involved the residents of the town of New Harmony in the University's programs there. After ten years as director, Mr. Sanders accepted a position as director of Corporate Relations at USI, and in that capacity he assisted with public relations and fund raising, playing a key role in the University's successful first capital campaign, *Campaign USI*. He also gave leadership to the establishment of the Art Collection Committee and obtained funding to support the teaching collection.

Mr. Sanders received a bachelor's degree in marketing from the University of Evansville and a master's degree in business from Indiana State University. An antiques expert, he lectures and teaches widely, including many international programs. He is a sought-after consultant and appraiser.

Many civic and professional organizations have benefited from Mr. Sanders's involvement. His memberships have included the boards of the national Decorative Arts Trust, Evansville Preservation Alliance, Evansville Museum of Arts and Science, Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra, Robert Lee Blaffer Trust, Posey County Community Foundation, Reitz Home Preservation Society, USI Foundation, U.S. Office of Education Region V, Ivy Tech State College Advisory Board for Office Education, University of Michigan Vocational Advisory Group, and the State Distributive Education Clubs of America. He is a past president of Harmonie Associates and past chair of the history committee of the Evansville Museum.

AIMEE LUEBBEN AND ERIC NORTON WILL RECEIVE UNIVERSITY'S HIGHEST HONORS

The University's highest honors will be awarded during today's ceremony to Dr. Aimee J. Luebben, associate program director and professor of occupational therapy, and Eric J. Norton, a senior from Bloomington, Indiana.

Dr. Luebben was chosen by her colleagues to receive the Integra Bank Distinguished Professor Award, given in recognition of significant achievement in teaching, scholarship, and service. One of Dr. Luebben's nominators wrote of her strengths "as an educator and administrator, her unwavering creativity in development of learning tools, her incredible productivity and persistence, and her firm belief in the ability of students to go beyond what they think they are capable of..."

The first director of USI's occupational therapy program, Dr. Luebben joined the University in 1992. She has overseen the design of curricula and steered the program through successful accreditation reviews in addition to her responsibilities for teaching and student advisement. Occupational therapy programs are offered at the associate, baccalaureate, and master's levels.

Dr. Luebben has served the University as a member of the Core Curriculum Council and as member and chair of the Faculty and Academic Affairs Committee. She is a member of the USI Disabled Student Advisory Committee, the USI Institutional Review Board, and the Epi-Hab/USI Center for Disability Studies Advisory Committee. She also serves as advisor to the Occupational Therapy Program Student Association and has been the advisor for the Golden Key Honor Society.

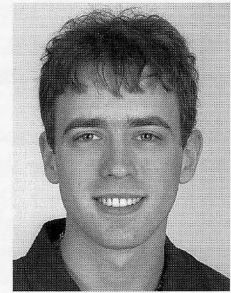
Active in community and professional organizations as well, she is a member of the HealthSouth Tri-State Regional Rehabilitation Hospital Advisory Board, Indiana Economic Development Council work groups, and Evansville-Vanderburgh School Corporation committees. Last year, in cooperation with other faculty, she launched WorkSolutions, which provides ergonomics and accessibility consultation through USI Extended Services. Evidence of her scholarship in her field can be found in the 125 articles she has had published in papers, book chapters, refereed abstracts, and editorials. She also makes national and international professional presentations.

Dr. Luebben received the Doctor in Education degree from Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville in 1997. She also holds a Bachelor of Arts from Illinois State University and both the Bachelor of Science in Occupational Therapy and Master of Science in Occupational Therapy from Washington University. Prior to joining USI, she taught at University of Missouri and Washington University and engaged in private practice as an occupational therapist.

As Distinguished Professor Dr. Luebben will receive a grant from Integra Bank, select a student to receive a scholarship in her name, and deliver the Distinguished Professor lecture during the next academic year.

The Student Affairs Committee of the Faculty Senate selected Eric Joseph Norton as this year's recipient of the President's Medal. He was chosen because of his commitment to academic excellence and his service to the University and the community.

Eric Norton is graduating *magna cum laude* with a major in English. He is a member of Sigma Tau Delta English honorary society, Golden Key national honor society, and Alpha Chi national honor society. For the past year he has been a member-at-large of the Student Honors Council.

Mr. Norton has participated in many university committees and co-curricular programs. He has been managing editor of *Aerie* student literary magazine and has acted in student plays produced by the Theatre department. Through the USI Honors Program, Mr. Norton has served as a student leader, training and preparing students for a public forum on biotechnology this spring. He also was chosen to attend USI's Honors Symposium.

A Habitat for Humanity volunteer, Mr. Norton also served as vice president of the USI Chapter of Habitat for Humanity. During summer 1998, he was a summer staff member in the Appalachia Service Project, organizing and overseeing the work of 800 volunteers who provided emergency home repair assistance to the poor near Brenton, West Virginia.

One of Mr. Norton's professors said that he is among "the three or four most socially aware and most dedicated to social improvement of the students I have taught over the past 25 years. He is precisely the sort of remarkable student for which the President's Medal is designed."

After graduation, Mr. Norton hopes to work in Teach for America and has requested an opportunity to be assigned to inner-city Chicago. His ultimate goal is to earn a Ph.D. in English literature and enter college teaching.

Mr. Norton is the son of Bruce and Rachael Norton from Bloomington, Indiana.

The other finalists for the President's Medal were Jill Bertke, Ryan Helzerman, Melissa Lindley, Kimberly Schwindel, and Kelly Sergesketter.

Presidential Medallion

During the Middle Ages, medallions signified membership in religious orders and guilds and, in the Renaissance, membership in elite orders of knighthood and prominence in government office. Today, colleges and universities strike medallions to commemorate important events and achievements. The University of Southern Indiana Presidential Medallion signifies the authority invested in the president.

Fabricated in bronze, the Presidential Medallion celebrates the 1995 inauguration of President H. Ray Hoops. At its center the bronze medallion bears a three-inch reproduction of the University seal, surrounded by a half-inch rim; on the back of the medallion are the names and dates of appointment of the University's presidents. During today's ceremony, a replica of the Presidential Medallion will be presented to Eric Norton. This is the highest honor given to a graduating senior.

University Seal

The University seal bears the University's colors — red, white, and blue — with gold. The shield signifies the importance of higher education in defending citizens against ignorance. Between the two banners carrying the University's name appear a band and an open book bound together by the torch of knowledge. In the band, rays of light emanate simultaneously from a rising sun, symbolizing the young University, and from the torch, symbolizing the light of knowledge and the passion for scholarship. Trees on either side of the flame suggest not only the University's pastoral southern Indiana setting but also life, growth, continuity.

Beneath this band, an open book emphasizes the importance of teaching and learning; *academia populi* and *academia populo* indicate that the University of Southern

Indiana is a scholarly academy founded and supported *by the people, for the people*. Finally, the laurel branches to the right and left of the book represent victory: the light of learning overcomes the darkness of ignorance.

University Mace

In the Middle Ages, bodyguards of French and English monarchs carried ceremonial maces. Later, the mace became an important symbol of office in civil processions and academic pageantry; at the University of Southern Indiana, the Grand Marshal, a distinguished member of the faculty, carries the mace.

A replica of the walking cane of Richard Owen (1810-1890) serves as the centerpiece of the University mace. A respected geologist and professor of natural science at Indiana University, Owen became the first president of Purdue University. He was a son of Robert Owen (1771-1858), the Welsh industrialist who established New Harmony, Indiana, as a center for education and enlightened social reform in the early 1800s. The 32-inch-tall, wooden cane was presented to Richard Owen in 1874 and, through the generosity of his descendant Kenneth D. Owen, served as the Grand Marshal's staff until the mace was fabricated for the University's first Presidential Inauguration in 1995.

Designed and fabricated by Nicholas Logsdon of Indianapolis, the University mace encloses a replica of the Owen cane and is gold-plated. At the top, above the cane's golden head, an open orb holds a replica of the University seal. The free-flowing design of the orb symbolizes the interrelationships among all academic disciplines. Below the cane's tip are three golden rings engraved with the names and appointment dates of the University presidents. A finial at the tip of the cane bears the names of Kenneth Dale Owen, Jane Blaffer Owen, and James A. Sanders, donors of the mace.

Designed and created by alumnus Kenny Fisher '77, the replica of the cane and the base are made of walnut from the Owen mansion built in New Harmony during the 1830s.

Academic Dress

The academic costume dates from medieval days when university students wore woolen and fur garments for warmth in damp and drafty buildings. Most of those studying were clerics in holy orders; they wore a cloak to which was attached a hood that could be pulled up to cover their tonsured heads. Simplified today, the costume serves to remind us that its wearer is a member of an ancient and venerable profession; it also indicates by its color and design the wearer's degree and the institution by which the degree was conferred.

In the United States, black has been the traditional color for academic gowns, but some institutions authorize holders of their doctorates to wear colors of the institution. The bachelor's gown is distinguished by its long, open sleeves; the master's by its closed, slitted sleeves; the doctor's by its full sleeves trimmed with bands of velvet, which may be black or a color denoting the field in which the degree was taken.

The mortarboard cap, proper for all degrees, is black. Tassels, usually black, are worn over the left front quarter of the cap. Holders of the doctorate may wear tassels of gold thread.

Academic hoods vary in length according to the degree attained and are lined with the colors of the institution by which the degree was granted. The honorary doctoral hoods of the University of Southern Indiana are black, lined with blue satin with red satin chevrons. They are edged with white velvet.

Alumni Association Pins

Graduates in today's ceremony are receiving lapel pins with the University logo as a gift of the University of Southern Indiana Alumni Association.

Baccalaureate Scholarship Honors

The baccalaureate degree candidate graduating with the highest scholarship index is graduated *summa cum laude*. Baccalaureate students graduating with a scholarship index of 3.80 or higher are graduated *magna cum laude*. Those with a scholarship index between 3.60 and 3.80 are graduated *cum laude*. These achievements are set forth on the individual diplomas. Honor students can be recognized in the Commencement Exercises by colored stoles and tassels. Gold indicates *summa cum laude*; red, *magna cum laude*; and blue, *cum laude*.

Because students enrolled in master's degree programs are expected to maintain a minimum grade-point average of 3.0, and most achieve much higher levels, scholarship honors at Commencement are given only to baccalaureate students.

University Honors Scholars

The designation of University Honors Scholar is awarded to students who successfully complete the Honors Program. They can be recognized in today's ceremony by the white honors cords worn with their regalia.

Photography During Ceremony

A commercial photographer is taking photographs of each graduate as he/she shakes hands with the President. Each graduate will receive a proof from which duplicates can be ordered. Family members who wish to take still or video photographs during the ceremony are asked to use the restricted area on the floor. Security guards will ask those who block aisles in the stands or occupy the area behind the stage to move. Your cooperation ensures the dignity of the Commencement ceremony.
